BUILDING PROJECT SPACE PROGRAMMING

MAIN CHAPEL AREA 3200 sq.ft

Seating for Approx.150 people
Features: Carpeted floors, raised podium, accoustical treatment, sound system, video projection system, cushioned pews for maximum seating and comfort, air-conditioned, stainglass windows, suitable for community concerts and gatherings

ADMINISTRATIVE OFFICES AND ENTRY 1000 sq. ft

Features: Two offices, restrooms at front of church, entry skylight with glass steeple

SOCIAL HALL/MEETING AREA 2400 sq. ft

Features: Seating for 75 people, ceramic tile, kitchen, restrooms, tables and chairs for social hours or conferences

LEASABLE OFFICE SPACE 2400 sq. ft

Leasable space divided into 6 to 8 office spaces

Features: Air conditioning, elevator, condominium or long term leases, providing income for church.

COMMON AND EQUIPMENT AREAS 1000 sq. ft Utilities, janitorial, storage

TOTAL SQUARE FOOTAGE 10,000 sq. ft

LANDSCAPED GROUNDS Outdoor seating areas, gardens, fountain

Background:

The ECOL was founded upon a dream, inspired by the love for life and the evolution of all humanity. A dream taught and demonstrated by Rev. Ralph Jordan, the founding dean who now resides upon the etheric planes of life but is still an influential force for upliftment in this world today.

During his tenure upon the earth plane, he established a religious non-profit organization which is still providing services where people from all walks of life can share the universal principles of truth in an environment of peace and brotherhood. Our mission is to continue these enduring universal philosophies and to provide a church and educational facility for many to share and work from in this time of change and uncertainty, and to provide a haven for personal growth and rejuvenation of body, mind and emotion.

History:

The ECOL was founded in 1993 as a 501 (c) 3 non-profit organization, incorporated in the state of Hawaii. The organization has been offering diversified programs with weekly church services, educational classes and workshops on understanding of all philosophical and religious affiliations, including spiritual and life consultations to assist the evolution of the individual and the community. The ECOL is already recognized as a spiritual, religious, and educational force with members from three continents.

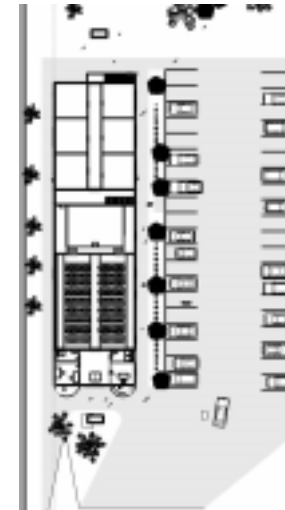
OBJECTIVES AND USAGE

1. To realize the goal of a modern educational facility and center to express many diversified cultures, philosophies and religions for individuals desirous of greater self-understanding, education and the evolution of their creative talents and abilities. People of similar purpose coming together to build the “mother house”, a physical temple to facilitate its many activities for spiritual enlightenment, education and healing.
2. A meeting place for training of healers, missionaries and ministers, regardless of race, age, or creed.
3. A place of retreat to refocus the spiritual and psychic powers of humanity to promote healing within themselves and shared with all societies.
4. A place of training, evolvment and reinforcement for spiritual demonstration of universal truths applied lovingly.
5. Appeal to the local and world community, generating interest and expansion for humanity to invest in this spiritual home, all in order to discover their recognized and unrecognized potentials.
6. Recruitment of new members to participate in a place of worship to celebrate their oneness with a universal spirit and their oneness with each other.
7. Events for the fellowship gatherings, weekly Sunday services, musical performances, weddings, and other social events.
8. Establishment of a library and educational research center with many of the spiritual writings, music and clairvoyant channelings of our founding dean, Ralph D. Jordan.

EXECUTION OF STRATEGY

1. Through reaching out to existing members and organizations with similar purposes.
2. Through pledge drives, a program of monthly and yearly pledges and donations in order to build and maintain our spiritual home.
3. Through leasing office space on a short and long term basis, of the rear office structure attached to the main sanctuary.
4. Through sale of the organization’s promotional materials and literature, including fundraising activities with the sale of RDJ artifacts.
5. Through multiple fundraising events and musical performances.
